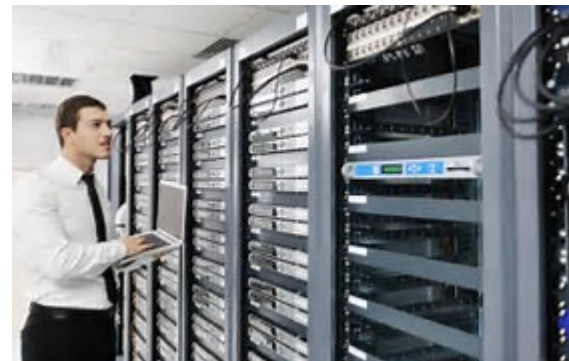
# COMPUTER SYSTEMS ANALYSIS
